Book by a single author:

Book by two authors:

Strunk, William, Jr., and E. B. White. *The Elements of Style*. 3rd ed. New York: Macmillan, 1979. Print.

Edited book:

Gibbs, Jewelle Taylor, and Larke Namhe Huang, eds. *Children of Color: Psychological Interventions with Minority Youth*. San Francisco: Jossey-Bass, 1991. Print.

Anonymous book:

Encyclopedia of Photography. New York: Crown, 1984. Print.

Multivolume edited work:

Koch, Sigmund, ed. *Psychology: A Study of Science*. 6 vols. New York: McGraw-Hill, 1959-63. Print.

Work in an anthology:

Allende, Isabel. "Toad's Mouth." Trans. Margaret Sayers Peden. *A Hammock Beneath the Mangoes: Stories from Latin America*. Ed. Thomas Colchie. New York: Plume, 1992. 83-88. Print.

An edition (of a work previously prepared for publication by another author):

Journal article:

Magazine article:

Posner, Michael I. "Seeing the Mind." *Science* 29 Oct. 1993: 673-74. Print.

Newspaper article, no author:

Article in a reference book:

Brakeley, Theresa C. "Mourning Songs." *Funk and Wagnalls Standard Dictionary of Folklore, Mythology, and Legend*. Ed. Maria Leach and Jerome Fried. Vol. 2. New York: Crowell, 1950. Print.

NOTE: for familiar reference works give only edition and year of publication, not full publication information
